**ORDER**


**THIS CAUSE** came before the Court on Receiver, Jonathan E. Perlman's Motion to Compel Turnover of Watches [ECF No. 187], filed October 11, 2018. The Receiver wishes to obtain custody of seven luxury watches, currently in the custody of the Sumter County Sheriff's Office. (*See generally id.*). The Receiver states Defendant, Dustin Pillonato, willfully violated the Court's June 7, 2018 Preliminary Injunction [ECF No. 64] by attempting to transfer the seven luxury watches — assets subject to the Asset Freeze set forth in the Preliminary Injunction. (*See generally Mot.*). The Sumter County Sheriff's Office would like to turn over the watches to the Receiver upon the Court's Order. (*See id.* 1). Being fully advised it is,

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. Receiver, Jonathan E. Perlman's Motion to Compel Turnover of Watches [ECF No. 187] is **GRANTED**.
2. The Sumter County, South Carolina, Sheriff's Office shall turn over the seven luxury watches currently in its custody to the Receiver to hold until further order of the Court.
